Parent Code of Ethics

I will remember that the game is for the players, not for the adults. I will not force my child to participate in a sports program and will make every effort to make my child's participation with CSA a positive experience. I will remember that children participate to have fun and that the game is for youth, not adults.

I will always be positive. I will be a positive role model for my child and encourage good sportsmanship at all times. I will show respect and courtesy and demonstrate positive support for all players, coaches, officials and spectators.

I will ensure my child is ready for all practices and games. I will be at the specified location on time with the appropriate uniform, equipment, and water, or provide my child's coach with an appropriate excuse beforehand.

I will teach my child that doing one's best is as important as winning, so that my child will never feel defeated by the outcome of a game or his/her performance. Furthermore, I will praise my child for competing fairly and trying hard, and recognize that skill development in dribbling, passing, finishing, fitness, and teamwork is as important as the final score.

I will encourage good sportsmanship. I will teach my child that soccer is a team sport, that every position on the field is an important one, and that the results of a game are not determined by the actions, performance, or abilities of just one player.

I will instruct my child to play by the rules and to resolve conflicts without resorting to hostility or violence. I also pledge to support the coach, referee, and/or CSA officials in regards to any disciplinary actions they may impose as a result of my child's failure to follow the rules or for any acts of physical violence.

I will respect the authority of the coaches, referee(s), and CSA officials. I will support the coaches, officials, and administrators working with my child. I will never question or confront a coach or referee during a game or in a public way; rather I will approach them with my concerns privately.

I will always allow the coach to be the only coach. I will refrain from coaching my child or other players during games and practices. Soccer is as much mental as physical and games provide an opportunity to implement skills, tactics, and strategies from practices. Additional sidelines instruction may be contradictory and divide players' attention from developing their own skills to think on their feet.

I will not come onto the field for any reason during the game, unless instructed by a coach in the case of an injury to my child.

I will not get into arguments with the opposing team's parents, players, or coaches. I will ask my child to treat other players, coaches, game officials, administrators, and fans with respect and demonstrate such behavior myself.

I will refrain from using abusive or profane language and will teach my child to do the same. I understand that profanity will not be tolerated at any time and parents or spectators using profanity will be asked to leave the CSA fields.

I will refrain from drugs, alcohol and tobacco at all CSA events. I will never attend a game, practice or event if I am under the influence of drugs or alcohol.

I will immediately inform a CSA Board member if a coach does or says anything inappropriate in the presence of my child, or any other players.
